## **Requirements for CYS:**

Complete the Capacity Building Assessment Tool for Organizations (CBAT-O) (Assessment available starting October 1, 2025)

IDHS has contracted with ICOY to assess, train, and work with the Department's youth services program providers to build trauma capacity. The Department's goal is to have 100% funded youth services providers achieving and maintaining a "Trauma-Informed" status. All IDHS funded sites are expected to participate in the CBAT-O trauma assessment, training opportunities, and suggested action plans, if determined necessary. Sites will not be penalized for their responses or the scores that result from the accuracy of the responses. **However, all IDHS sites are expected to have a minimum of 80% participation across all staff levels.** The expectation is for all sites to experience growth in their delivery of trauma-informed services.

- Service providers are encouraged to attend all CBAT-O webinars and events throughout the fiscal year. Participation in the CBAT-O Learning Community is expected of all participants in the Spring of 2026.
- Participants must complete 5 training sessions, including at least 1 inperson session.; you may choose from any of the topics listed below:
- Building a Trauma-Informed Organization
- Community Trauma and Resiliency
- Culture and Trauma

- Developmental Trauma and Maternal Stress
- Engaged and Empowered: Fundamentals to Trauma-Informed Youth Engagement
- Resisting Vicarious Trauma: Building Resilience and Collective Care in the Workplace
- The Intersection of LGBTQ+ Identity and Systems
- The Impact of Trauma on Youth
- Train the Trainer: Trauma-Informed Supervision for Supervisors
- Trauma and Grief
- Trauma and Juvenile Delinquency
- Trauma-Informed De-Escalation
- Trauma-Informed Supervision for Supervisors
