Requirements for Redeploy:

Complete the Capacity Building Assessment Tool for Organizations (CBAT-O) (Assessment opens on October 1, 2026 and closes October 31, 2026)

- **All staff working under an IDHS grant are expected and required to take the CBAT-O assessment.** The expectation is for all sites to experience growth in their delivery of trauma-informed services.
- Attend an 'Introduction to the CBAT-O' webinar. **At least one program manager from each participating agency is required to attend.**
- Participation in a CBAT-O Learning Community is expected of all participants in the Spring of 2027.

Participants must complete 5 training sessions, including at least 1 in-person session; you may choose from any of the topics listed below:

- Building a Trauma-Informed Organization
- Caring for the Carer: Beyond Self-Care
- Community Trauma and Resiliency
- Complex Trauma & Human Trafficking
- De-escalation: A Strengths-Based Approach

- Poverty and Trauma
