Requirements for Teen REACH:

Complete the Capacity Building Assessment Tool for Organizations (CBAT-O) *(Assessment opens on October 1, 2026 and closes October 31, 2026)*

- **All staff working under an IDHS grant are expected and required to take the CBAT-O assessment.** The expectation is for all sites to experience growth in their delivery of trauma-informed services.
- Attend an 'Introduction to the CBAT-O' webinar. ***At least one program manager from each participating agency is required to attend.***
- *Service providers are encouraged to attend our CBAT-O webinars and events throughout the fiscal year.*
